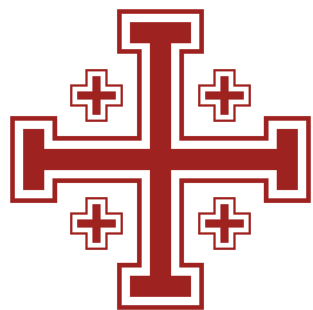

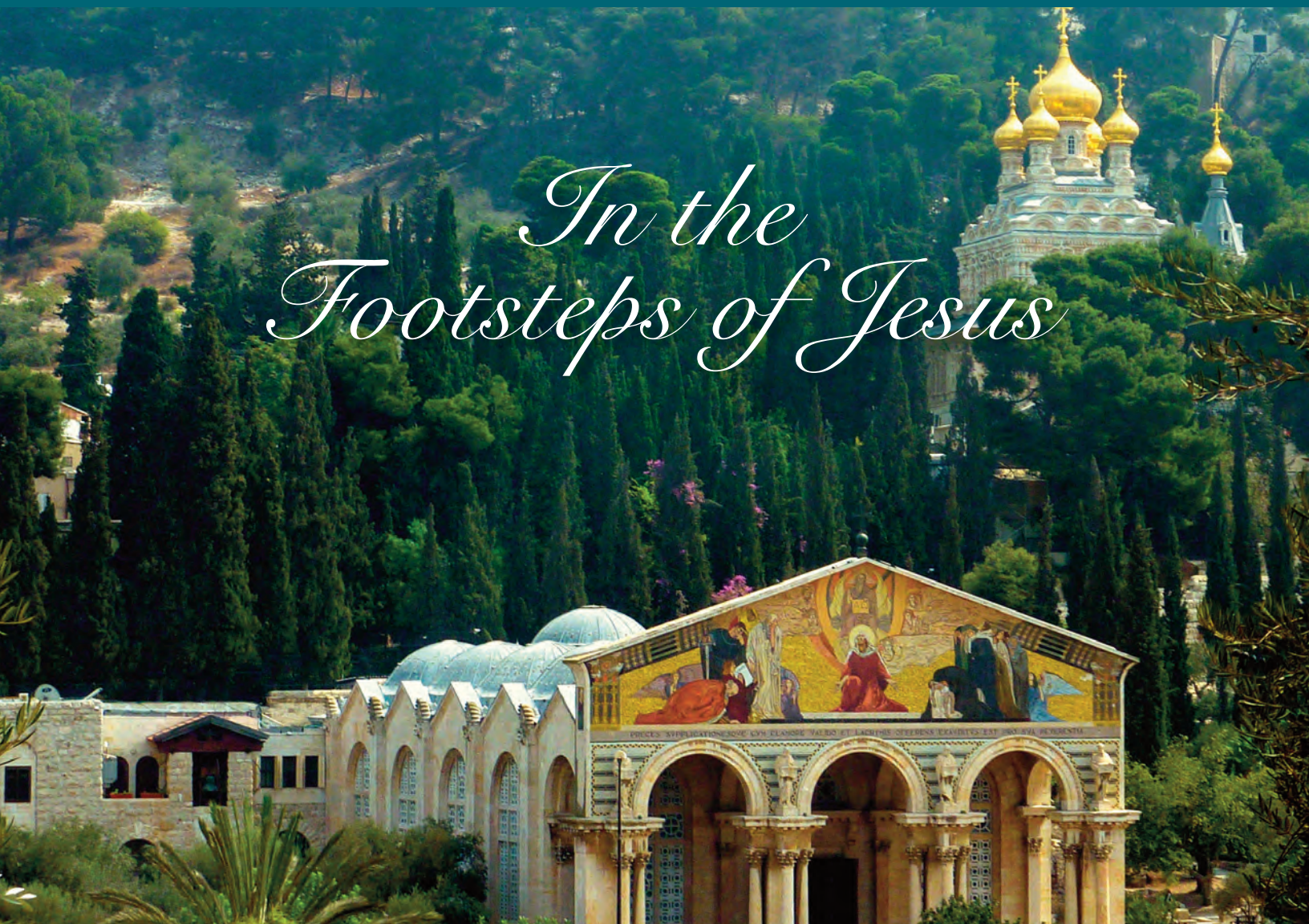

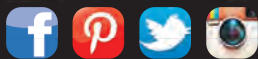

Day 1 September 15, Sunday: Depart USA

Depart John F. Kennedy International Airport on EL AL Israel Airlines for our Pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

Complimentary meals and beverages will be served in flight. (D,B,L)

Day 2 September 16, Monday: Arrive Tel Aviv | Caesarea Maritima | Sea of Galilee

Early afternoon arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way tour manager / guide will meet us as we exit Customs. Board our private touring bus and we will be on our way to the scenic Mediterranean coast. We will stop at Caesarea by the Sea, site of a flourishing early Christian community, where the ruins of Turkish, Crusader and Roman Civilizations are still visible. Biblically, St. Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome for trial. It was here also that St. Peter baptized the first Gentiles. Our visit includes the Theatre, newly excavated Palace, Hippodrome and the Harbor. Continue to the Sea of Galilee, for hotel check-in. **Celebrate Mass.** Then, freshen up for dinner.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in the Galilee. (D)

Day 3 September 17, Tuesday: Cana | Nazareth | Mt. Carmel

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Our day begins with a visit to Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. The wedding church was built in the nineteenth century over ruins from Jesus' time. See the display of stone jars and reflect on the miracle of the changing of water into wine. Couples will have an opportunity to renew their marriage vows. Then, we continue to Nazareth, the village in which Jesus grew up and lived most of his life. **Celebrate Mass in the Basilica of the Annunciation.** After Mass, visit Joseph's workshop, Mary's Well, and the Church of the Old Synagogue, which marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. Independent lunch with free time to explore Nazareth. After lunch, drive to the Mediterranean coast en-route to Mt. Carmel to visit Stella Maris, the largest monastery of the Carmelite order, dedicated to the Virgin Mary. Enjoy the breathtaking view from atop Mt. Carmel. Return to the Sea of Galilee.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in the Galilee. (B,D)

Day 4 September 18, Wednesday: Around the Sea of Galilee | Bethsaida | Korazim | Capernaum | Tabgha

Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, begin our day with a visit to Bethsaida. Jesus criticized the Galilean fishing village of Bethsaida for its inhabitants' "lack of faith". At Bethsaida, Peter, Andrew and Philip responded to Jesus call and gave up everything to follow him. Continue on to Korazim, situated on a hill above the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee, where fishermen in Jesus' time would have lived. Here, Jesus performed many miracles, yet disbelief prevailed, as in Capernaum and Bethsaida (Matthew 11:20-24). See the remains of an ancient synagogue, which for pilgrims commemorates those areas where Jesus walked and preached. Continue to the summit of the Mount of Beatitudes to visit the International Center "Domus Galilaeae." We will be welcomed by the Neocatechumenal Way community for a guided visit that will culminate in **Eucharistic celebration in the Church.** Independent lunch. After lunch, visit the ancient city of Capernaum, where Jesus started His ministry. It was here that Jesus found Matthew and called him to discipleship. See a 2nd century synagogue, in excellent condition, believed to have enclosed the sacred sanctuary in which Jesus taught and preached. Most Scripture scholars recognize the home of Peter's mother-in-law in the remains of a church near the shore and dedicated to his honor. Continue to Tabgha. Visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter, on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. This modest Church marks the place (Mensa Christi) where Jesus prepared breakfast on a charcoal fire (John 21), and the moment when Jesus says to Peter, "...Feed my sheep." Our day ends with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. The Gospels come to life as you imagine when Jesus walked on the water (John 6:19-21), calmed a storm (Matt. 8:23-26), and showed the disciples miraculous catches of fish (Luke 5:1-8).

Dinner and overnight at hotel in the Galilee. (B,D)

Day 5 September 19, Thursday: Mt. Tabor | Jericho | Jordan River | Jerusalem

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Today's bus journey is filled with variety and excitement. Leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to Mt. Tabor. At the foot of Mt. Tabor take taxis to the top where the elevation provides an utterly commanding view of all of Galilee. It was here that Jesus revealed the wonderful power of presence in communion with Saints of the past (Moses and Elijah). **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Transfiguration.** Continue along the Jordan Valley and marvel at

the desert blooming with beautiful flowers, fruits and vegetables. Arrive in Jericho for independent lunch. After lunch, we will explore Jericho, home of Joshua, Elijah's spring, Jesus' miracles and the Mt. of Temptation. Near the center of the city, a centuries-old sycamore tree recalls the incident in which the tax collector Zacchaeus, too short to see over the crowd, climbed a sycamore's branches in order to see Jesus. Then, we will make a brief stop at the Jordan River, the traditional Baptismal site and the Dead Sea before we continue our journey "up to Jerusalem" from the shoreline of the lowest point on earth. As we make our way to Jerusalem, we will pass by the "Inn of the Good Samaritan." Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 6 September 20, Friday: Bethlehem | Shepherds' Field | Mt. Olives | Mt. Zion | Gethsemane

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Begin our day with a drive to the hills of Bethlehem. Upon arrival we will visit Shepherds' Field, where you will see some of the caves, which are typical of the stables of that time. The highlight of your time in Bethlehem will be a visit to the traditional birthplace of Jesus, in the Basilica of the Nativity. Here, the Prince of Peace was born! Venerate the silver star that marks the place where the sublime mystery of the Incarnation was revealed in a manger! **Celebrate Mass at one of the Grotto Chapels beneath the Church of the Nativity.** Free time will be given for shopping and browsing in Manger Square. Independent lunch. Then, we will drive to the top of Mount of Olives. The summit offers a magnificent view of the Old City. This visit reminds us of Jesus' last hours in prayer and anguish as he faced his passion and death. Visit the Shrine of Pater Noster and the Chapel of Dominus Flevit (The Lord Wept). Then, follow Jesus' Palm Sunday route along Hosanna Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Continue on to Mt. Zion, to visit the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper and descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. We will also visit the Dormition Abbey built to honor the Assumption of Our Lady. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 7 September 21, Saturday: Bethany | Wilderness of Judea Masada | Dead Sea

Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, we will visit Bethany, where Martha, Mary and Lazarus welcomed Jesus in their home. Bethany is also the house of Simon the leper. Here, Jesus was anointed, as if for burial, by a very special woman. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Lazarus.** After Mass, visit the traditional tomb of Lazarus and then drive to Masada, the site of one of Herod's winter palaces and the famous last stand of the Zealots. We will take a cable car, then walk (climb) to the tomb and explore the Herodian palaces, water cistern, Roman bath House, storage Houses and Roman siege Camp. Independent lunch. Visit the Dead Sea, and you will have a panoramic view of Ein Gedi, where David hid from Saul's wrath and the locale of the Song of Songs. Later, we will visit the area of Qumran, where the hidden library of the Essenes, the Dead Sea Scrolls (currently displayed at the Israel Museum), were found in 1947. Return to Jerusalem.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 8 September 22, Sunday: Temple Mount and Old City | Ein Karem

Early morning Mass at the Empty Tomb (to be confirmed). Return to the hotel for buffet breakfast. Then we will explore the City of David, which will lead us to the Western Wall of the Temple Mount where we will pray. Above the Temple foundations, we view the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. Visit the excavation of the Western Wall (Ophel Hill). Walking through the narrow alleyways and streets of Jerusalem seeing the Pinnacle of the Temple (Gate of Hulda - after Pentecost, it was here where the disciples preached and baptized). We will also visit the newly constructed Jewish Quarter "Cardo" and will arrive in the center of city. Independent lunch. After lunch we will visit Ein Karem, home of Elizabeth and Zachariah, and birthplace of St. John the Baptist. See the Church of the Visitation, one of the most artistic in the Holy Land. Time will be given for quiet meditation as we pray the verses from the Magnificat, engraved on the columns of the church, and on opposite walls in forty-two different languages. We will also visit the Church of St. John the Baptist. On our return to Jerusalem we will visit the Israel Museum. Among many works we will see a to-scale model of Jerusalem in the Second Temple Period, which reconstructs the topography and architectural character of the city as it was in the days of Jesus. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 9 September 23, Monday: Via Dolorosa | Free Afternoon | Evening Transfer to Airport

Following early breakfast, drive to the Old City and enter through St. Stephen's Gate. Continue to the convent of the Sisters of Zion to see the Lithostrotos in the chapel of the Flagellation, where Jesus was tried and condemned. From here we will start the Via Crucis and follow the Stations of the Cross to Calvary. **Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Blessed Sacrament in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre.** Independent lunch. This afternoon is free to explore Jerusalem on our own. (Time permitting, possible visit to Mamre.)

This evening, enjoy a festive farewell dinner at the Ambassador Hotel. Following dinner, freshen-up for our evening transfer to Tel Aviv Airport. Overnight on your non-stop flight to the USA. (B,D)

Day 10 September 24, Tuesday: Arrive in the USA

Early morning, arrive in New York filled with memories that will change your life.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Israeli New Shekel valuation to the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months**, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents, including passport.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip economy class on **EI Al from New York**. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Additionally, if you purchase any connecting airfare and the group does not materialize, or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for cost of this airfare.

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. **All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently.** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package **(\$2,095.00 per person sharing a twin room - a \$100 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check)** must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing a hotel room with two twin beds with private facilities. Married couples may request a double bed, however, double beds are subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, however, there is no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. If confirmed, an **additional charge of \$595.00** will apply. We will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests, but we cannot guarantee double occupancy. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast & dinner daily, including farewell dinner on September 23rd.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, we recommend \$7.00 per person per day for your tour manager, and \$3.00 per person per day for your bus driver. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others.
